

# Tips for eBook Searching

## Help

-The Help button in the upper right hand corner of the screen really is helpful!

- If you know the title or author, use the Search tab for faster results.
- Use  Only show titles with copies available, if you want a book “right now.”
- Pay attention to the format of the item you are checking out to download. You will have to choose between Kindle, Adobe EPUB or PDF, Open EPUB, Overdrive MP3 or WMA Audiobooks, Music, Video or Disney Online Books.

Format:

- Don't know which format to use? [Now you do.](#)
- WMA audiobooks will not download to or play on a Mac. Consequently, if you use a Mac, you can't transfer this audio format to your iPod. Mp3 audiobooks will work.
- If you have a supported smartphone (iPhone, Android, Blackberry, Windows phone), or iDevice, use the [Overdrive app](#) to download mp3 format audios and EPUB format ebooks directly to your phone!
- If you are having problems downloading to your eReader device, make sure that you have:
  - Adobe Digital Editions installed (opening it is a good way to test)
  - activated Adobe Digital Editions and device with an Adobe ID
  - can see device as a bookshelf in the left panel of Adobe Digital Editions, and
  - are using Adobe Digital Editions to transfer the ebook to the reader (NOT doing the drag-and-drop process in Windows Explorer).
- **My Help!** beta can be found on the Digital Download Center on the left side of the page, and it provides information about getting started and assistance for a user's specific computer or device.
